Proceedings:

The Chairperson, **Dr. Kumar Swamy V.**, extended a warm welcome to all the members and expressed gratitude for their presence and active participation. The meeting commenced at 9:30 A.M.

2. Members collectively recommended that the structure of the scheme be finalized before delving into course-specific discussions.
3. **Dr. B.S. Khened** proposed integrating the subjects of Generation, Transmission, and Distribution into a unified course, instead of handling them individually. He also recommended moving the Power Systems course from the 5th to the 6th semester.
4. **Dr. Sharana Reddy** recommended including *Linear Integrated Circuits* in the 5th semester and emphasized incorporating software and placement-oriented courses such as *Object-Oriented Programming Systems (OOPS)*. He also advised the inclusion of *Electrical Tariffs* as a module under *Management and Entrepreneurship*.
5. **Dr. Ramesh L. Chakrasali** suggested correcting typographical errors and ensuring the distribution of 120 instructional hours across basic electrical courses is accurate. He recommended the inclusion of emerging technologies such as *Artificial Intelligence* and *Internet of Things (IoT)* as Professional Electives. For the Control Systems course, he suggested using *Control Systems by Katsuhiko Ogata, 5th Edition*.
6. **Dr. Nagabhushan Patil** proposed combining *Switchgear & Protection* and *High Voltage Engineering* into a single course. He also recommended introducing *Computer-Aided Electrical Drawing (CAED)* in the 6th semester under Skill Enhancement Courses.
7. **Dr. Vinoda S** suggested to delete last portions of T and D and recommended to move industrial drives and control course as IPCC.
8. **Mrs. Amrutha G.E.** recorded the suggestions and highlighted the importance of including a course on *Electrical and Electronics Measurements*.
9. **Mr. Kesari Hanumanthu** emphasized that the *Linear Integrated Circuits* course is instrumental in developing quality student projects.



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10. There was a unanimous agreement among members on the need for an *Open Elective* course to expose students to interdisciplinary and trending technologies across programs.
11. The Chairperson, **Dr. Kumar Swamy V.**, thanked all members for their valuable inputs, both online and offline. He informed the committee that the revised scheme and syllabus document would be shared via email by the evening of **20th May 2025** for final approval.
