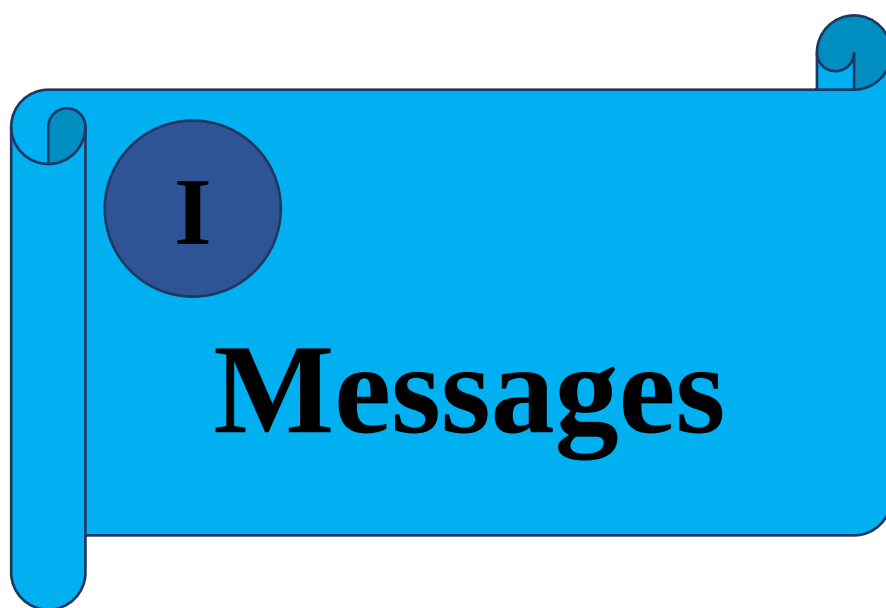

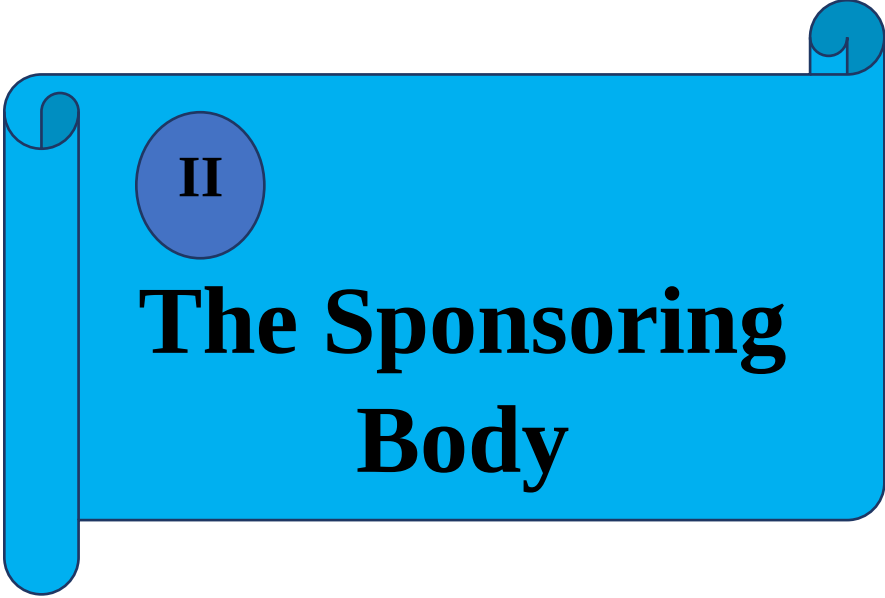

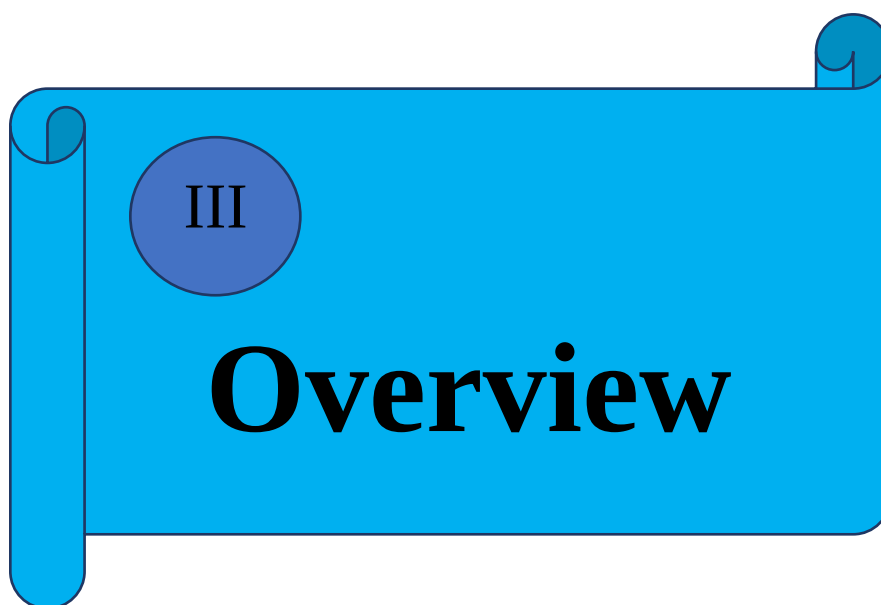

Kishkinda University was established by an act of Government of Karnataka No. 20 of 2023 and published in the Gazette of Karnataka, dated: 05/08/2023. The Government has permitted the sponsoring body, T.E.H.R.D Trust to offer 3 Under Graduation programs in Engineering and BCA, 2 Post Graduation Programs in MBA and MCA to begin with and accorded approval to start this programs in the existing BITM Campus. Further the Government has clearly indicated to create necessary infrastructure in the main campus situated near siruguppa road about 28 KMS from the city of Ballari. The University Started function accordingly by appointing the various authorities as per the provision of the act. The University is expected to operate from the Main Campus by the commencement of the academic year 2025-26. The next section provides the Vision, Mission and Objectives, Core Values of the University.

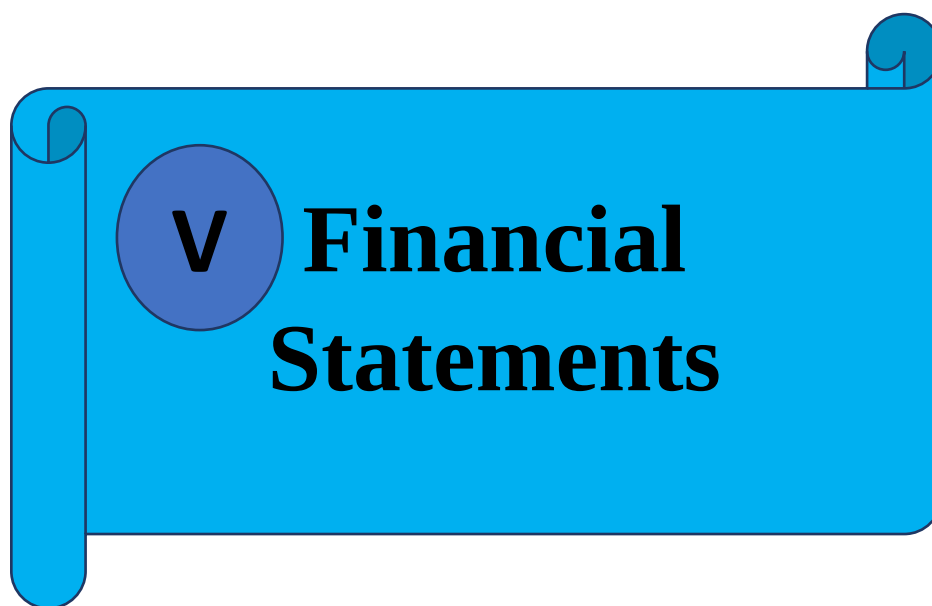
The important activities of the examination division includes:
