Each course consists of five modules covering the relevant content of the subject, including fundamental concepts, industry requirements, and aspects of new technologies. Some courses in the curriculum have been developed with a multidisciplinary approach, such as Cyber Security, Python Programming, Research Methodology, Microcontrollers, and Embedded Systems. Eighty percent (80%) of our courses provide hands-on experience through laboratory experiments. The concepts taught in the

		classroom are practiced and executed by students in the laboratory on the same day.
